

Description

- ◆ St Margaret's Hospice is an existing facility specialising in the care of the terminally ill. The new 16 bedroom extension was developed with the Client to achieve a high standard of care, with new Nurses Station and assisted bathrooms.

Involvement

- ◆ Centralised air system was designed to serve all wards and bed spaces. The use of infra-red taps was utilised in order to reduce contamination. Direct fired condensing hot water generators were utilised to increase the efficiency and to reduce the possibility of legionella.
- ◆ Bed head services were included to allow individual televisions to be installed at each location.
- ◆ The services included ventilation, medical classes, heating, domestic services, electrical power and infrastructure including bed head services.
- ◆ A new emergency generator was specified to meet the requirements of the whole site.
- ◆ Full Nurse Call provision.
