

### Description

- ◆ £150k redevelopment of BRI Phase 4 Works on level 5 of the Bristol Royal Infirmary (BRI)
- ◆ Improvement to patient flow throughout the hospital by taking around 150 patients a week from wards in the BRI and BHI
- ◆ Existing MEMO offices workshop remodelled to become a discharge lounge
- ◆ The programme was of a short nature with SDS heavily involved throughout
- ◆ Due to the fast-track nature many items, including pneumatic tube systems were ever changing
- ◆ AC VRF, heat recovery system
- ◆ LED lighting
- ◆ Air tube system



### Involvement

- ◆ Full M&E design to refurbished area allowing change of use

### Benefits Delivered

- ◆ An area of the building had a problem with heat gain. By providing a new VRF system the issue was effectively resolved with the added benefit of an energy efficient solution
